At Forge International, we know how much of a burden school supplies can put on family budgets. That is why we don't do traditional supply lists. There is no expectation that students arrive with their own individual supplies. We simply ask families to voluntarily donate what they can to the community supply closet.

Individual Supplies

The only recommended personal purchase for each student is a set of headphones/earbuds. Given the necessity of these items for testing and accessing computer technology in the school, these items will be provided, but in limited supply and will need to be shared between multiple students. Many students prefer to have their own headphones/earbuds based on comfort and sanitation factors. All headphones/earbuds should have a 3.5mm (½") connector and should be labeled with the student's name.

1 pair of headphones or earbuds (labeled with student's name)

Individual school supplies may be brought in by students (labeled with the student's name) and will be placed into the student's personal supply box.

Face Covering(s). In absence of a local health order, masks/face shields are encouraged and expected for the health and safety of others, but will not be required. If students/families are unable to provide a mask, a disposable mask will be provided for the day and school staff will work with families to provide other reusable options. If the local health district enacts a health order for Canyon County or Middleton, masks/face shields will be required as per the order. If there are individual circumstances based on a documented physical condition, mental health condition, or disability, decisions will be made on a case-by-case basis.

Request for Classroom Supply Donations

Based on our estimates, these are the projected items that a single student will use during a single school year. Individual school supplies may be brought in by students (labeled with the student's name) and will be placed into the student's personal supply box. Donations will be collected, disinfected and distributed to each individual student.
