Communications:

- Please email all general questions to info@forgeintl.org to help us streamline our communications flow. My email has blown up and I want to make sure that communication doesn't get overlooked. We also want to ensure that we answer the questions once and not have to repeat them multiple times to save us time and energy.
- Website development is taking place to help put all relevant information in a common spot from a FAQ perspective. Text alerts will go out with each website update.
- To ensure all parent/guardians are receiving emails, we will also be forwarding our standard School Messenger emails through a BCC to all emails we have listed in Skyward. This may cause many of you to receive duplicates. Thank you for your understanding as we work to ensure that all families and guardians have the information they need.
- To ensure you receive the text alerts, send 'Y' or 'Yes" to 67587.

Facilities:

 Staff began a deep clean of doors and walls last Friday and will continue to disinfect classroom furniture and deep clean throughout the building.

Learning:

- Plans are being developed to send Chromebooks home along with some paper copy materials and school supplies.
- Teachers will be developing learning plans to help give guidance to parents at home about potential routines and activities.

Nutrition:

- We are working with the State Department on nutrition solutions.
